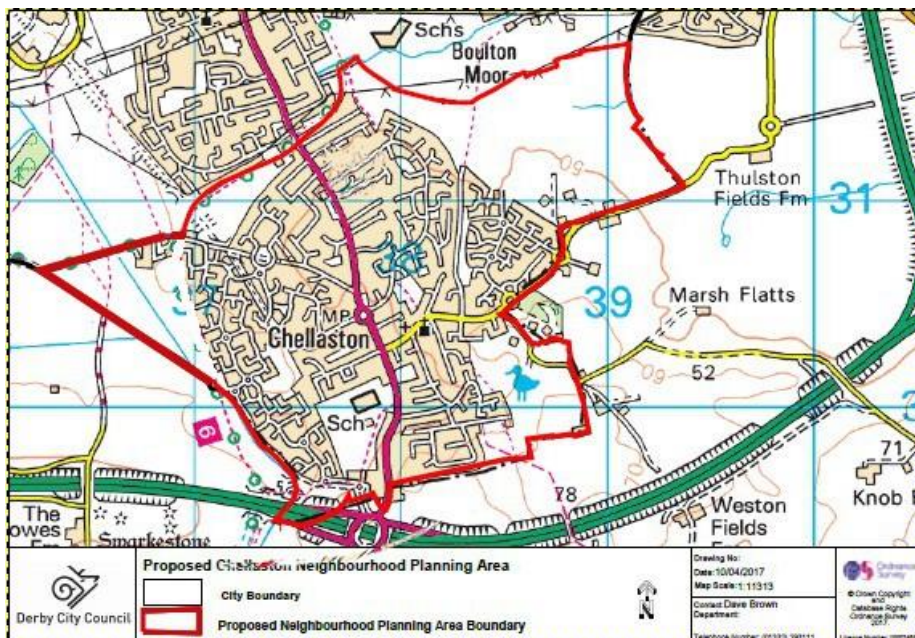


Chellaston Neighbourhood Planning Forum.

Draft Minutes of Inaugural meeting - Saturday 4th February 2017

Apologies:

30 people attended the meeting. 25 were willing to become forum members plus the 6 businesses making a total of 31 forum members.

Welcome and Overview:

Ann Witheford (acting chair) gave a short history and overview of the Neighbourhood Planning Forum including how the designated area was decided. She explained how we had got to this point and what was required in the future as we begin to develop our neighbourhood plan. Ann also explained the structure of the forum, the requirement of at least 21 forum members to take the project to the next stage.

Q. A question was asked whether the membership of the forum was restricted to the designated area or could residents from the whole of Chellaston take part. It was felt that the wording of the constitution was ambiguous. It was suggested that the committee would look at the wording and make an alteration to the wording which could be approved at the next full forum meeting in April. **Action - GD**

Q. A resident asked if other areas could become neighbourhood forums and be appended to the current designated area eg. West Chellaston, East Chellaston and North Chellaston.

He felt that residents not in the designated area have been disenfranchised. It was pointed out that we had advertised the meetings in all areas of Chellaston and Shelton Lock and that articles had been placed in Chellaston Matters which goes to 5000 houses in Chellaston and also in Chellaston Choice which goes into at least 6500 homes. We had also hand delivered 2000 flyers through doors. There was not much else we could do to advertise the CNPF. On all the advertising we had made it clear that although the historic centre of the village was the designated area, we wanted the comments, opinion and support from all residents.

The consensus at the meeting was that the area to be consulted should be down to the historic ward boundary which was at the Bridge Inn. Gill Donaldson explained that when the examiner came to

deciding where the referendum should take place, he will look at how widely we have consulted with residents. **Action - GD to get advice on this.**

Q. Were there any other areas that had Neighbourhood Planning Documents. Gill Donaldson replied that Chellaston was the first area in Derby but that we had been looking at the plans of other areas and intend to contact them to get their advice. **Action – AW**
